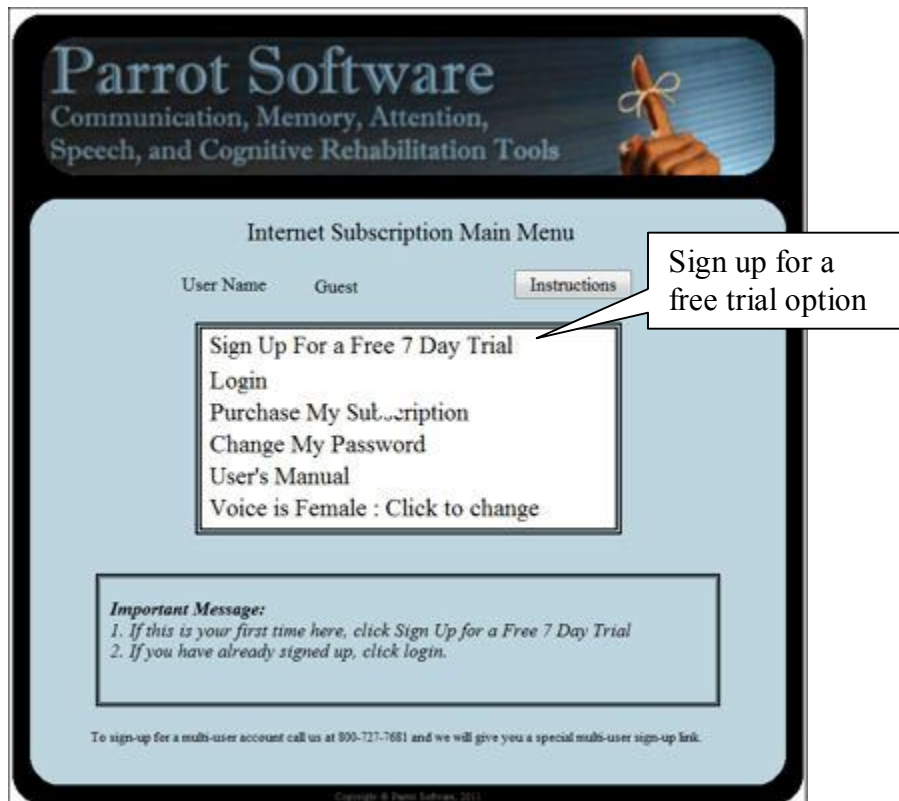


Internet Subscription Manual of Instructions

Quick Start

When you first go to the Parrot Software Internet Subscription Main menu, you will see the following screen with an option to sign up for a Free Trial.



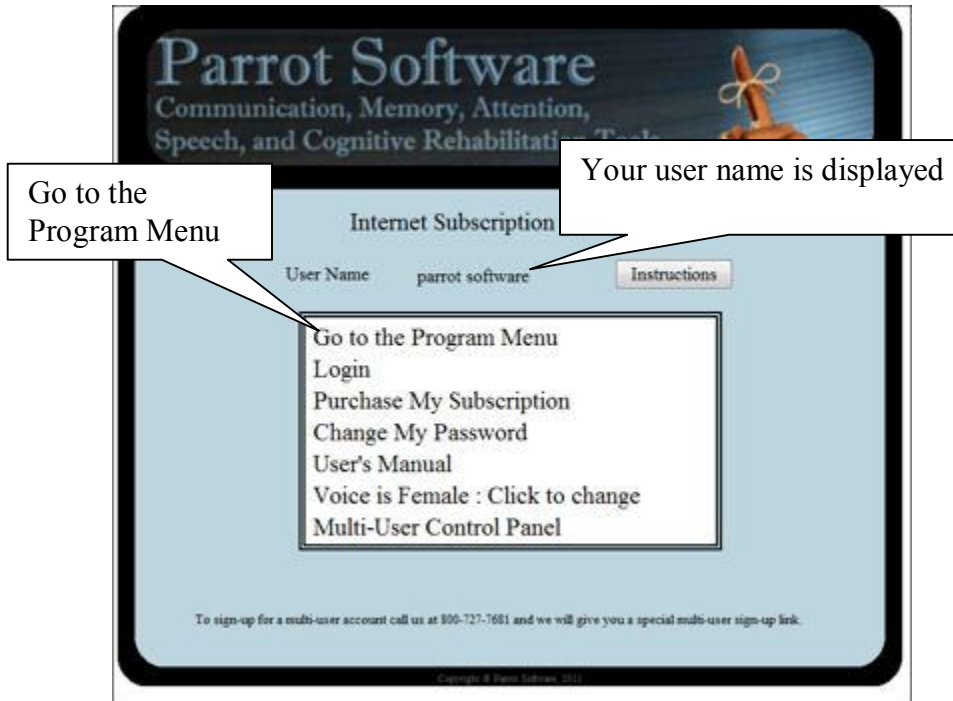
Click on the free trial option and you will see the following screen:

Enter a user name that you think will be distinctive and not used by anyone else. Then enter a password twice and your email address. Next enter the name people call you, e.g. John, Fred, etc.

Next enter the year you were born, your gender, the reason for signing up, and your phone number. Finally, click the Create User button. You will see a page telling you that your signup was successful. Click OK and you will see the Main Menu.

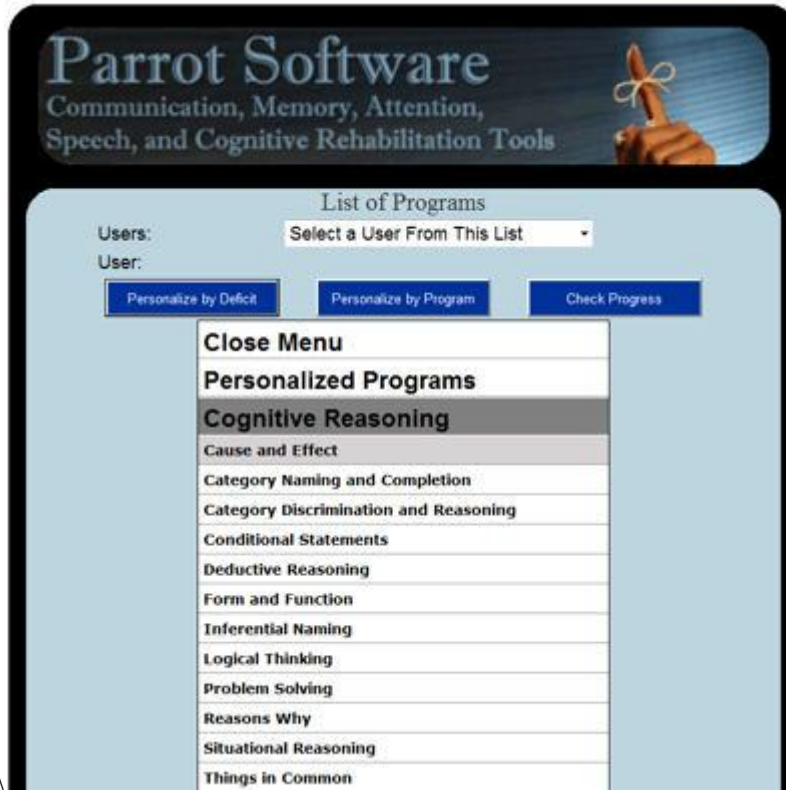
You will see that the word 'guest' is replaced by your user name and the free trial offer is replaced by 'Go to the Program Menu'.



Click on the 'Go to the Program Menu' option and you will see the following screen:



You are now ready to run your first program. Click on Cognitive Reasoning. You will see the following:



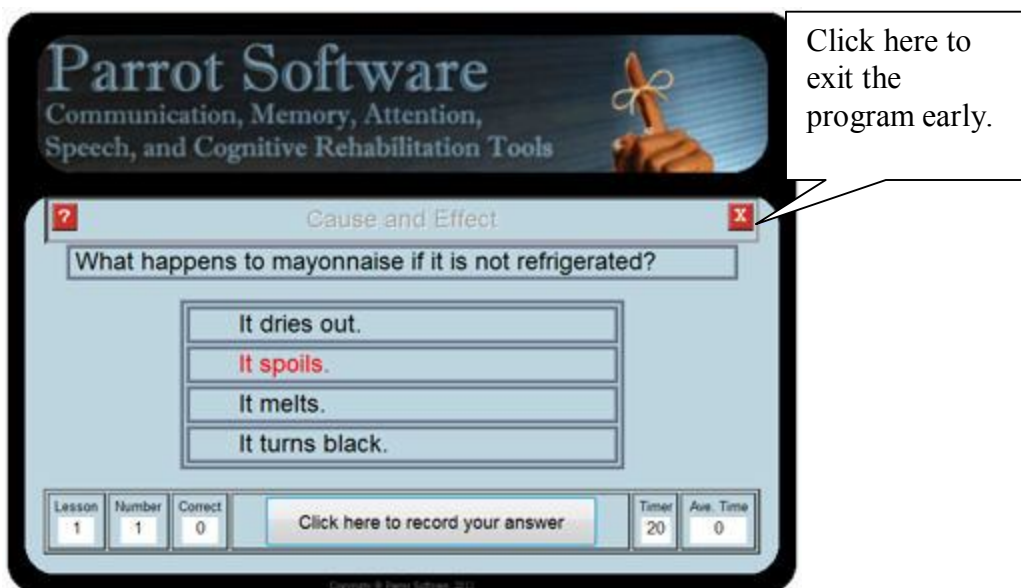
All of the programs within the Cognitive Reasoning category will be listed. Click on the first program: 'Cause and Effect' and you will see the following screen:



This is the Lesson Selection screen. Click Continue to select Lesson 1. You will then see the opening screen for Cause and Effect.



Click the large button at the bottom of this screen to start the lesson. You will see the following:



The program will read the question aloud. Choose the item that best answers the question. The program will read your answer aloud. Then click the large button at the bottom of the screen to record your answer. The program will tell you if you were correct or incorrect. Then click the large button again to go to the next question. Continue until you have completed all of the questions in this lesson or click the X in the red box to end the lesson. After ending the program, you will see a screen similar to the following:



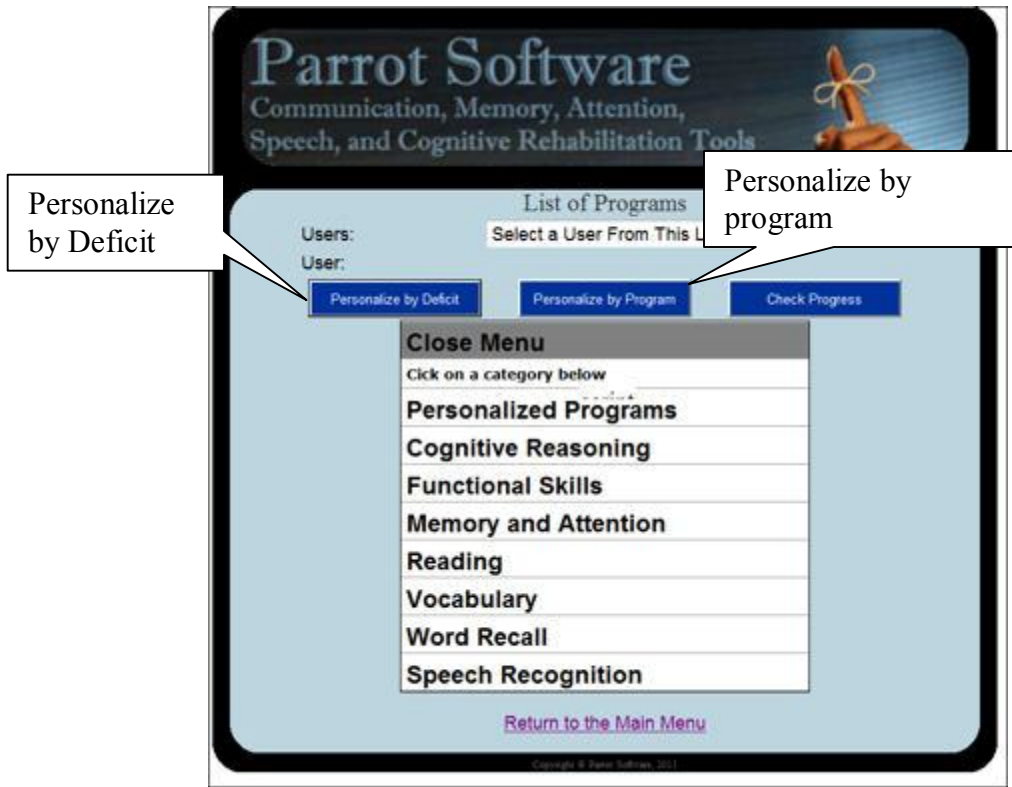
This screen shows a summary of your performance for that lesson. Next either click: 'Try the program again' or 'Return to the Program Menu'.

Personalized Programs

The program will help you select the most appropriate programs for your problems.

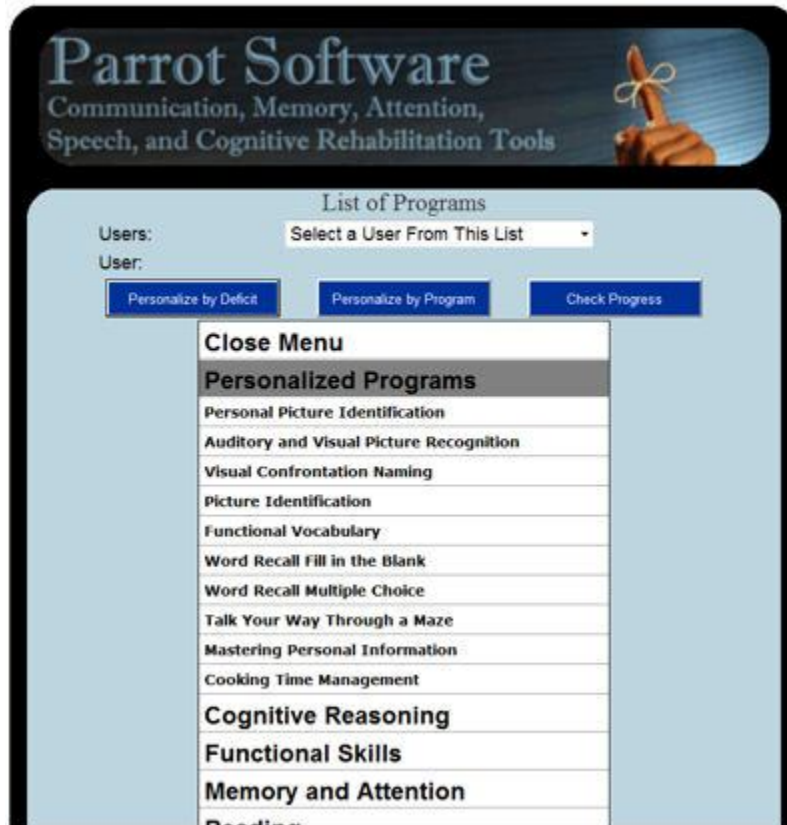


Click on the Personalize by Deficit button. You will see the following screen:

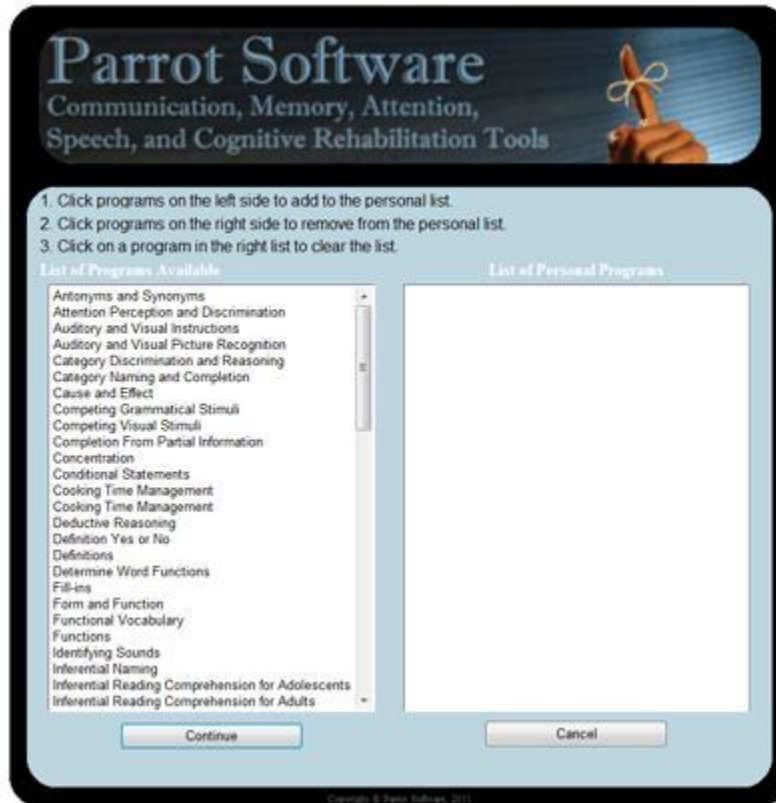


This screen has 30 statements. Select between 1 and 4 statements that describe your most pressing problems. Then click the Continue button at the bottom. You will return to the program Menu.

Next click on the Personalized Programs option. You will see the list of programs that we recommend you start using based on the statements you selected.



After you become more familiar with the programs, you can put specific programs in the Personalize Programs list. Click on Personalize by Program. You will see the following screen:



Go through the list and click on the programs you want to include. As you click them, they will move over to the right side. When you have made all your selections, click the Continue button. All of the programs on the right side will be included in the Personalized Programs list.

This subscription tracks your progress over time. You can see your progress by clicking on the progress button on the Program Menu.



After clicking this button you will see your progress over time similar to the following:

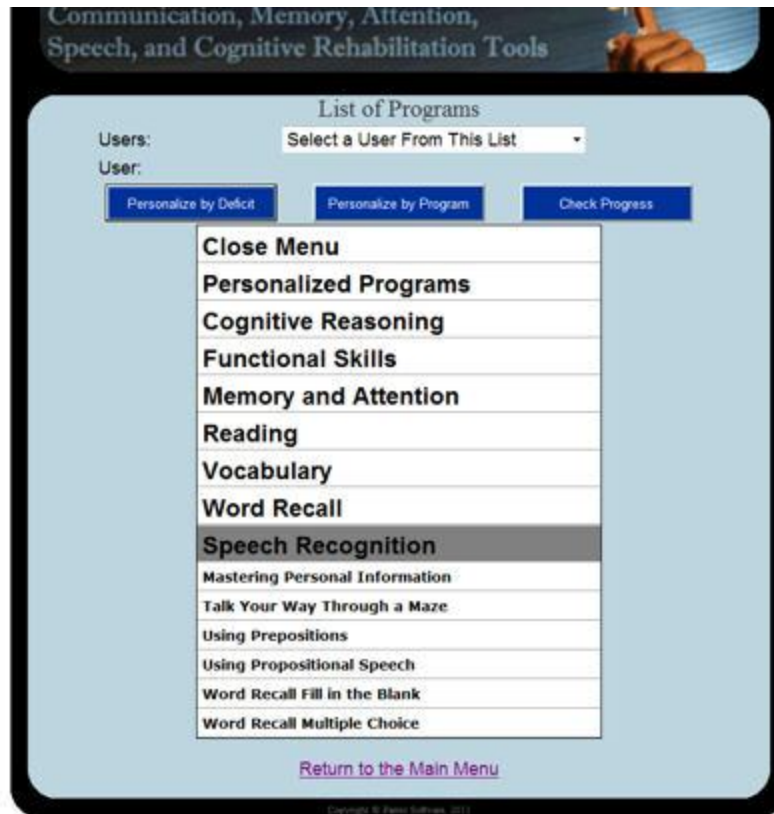

Use of these programs requires a Windows operating system, 512 MB RAM, a unidirectional microphone, and an installation of our Custom Browser. When you try to use one of these programs, without installing the Custom Browser, you will be directed to a special download and install page where you can click a link to download the program or you can type the following in your browser:

If the installation tells you that a Microsoft Framework is missing, do the following: Go to www.microsoft.com and search for 'download framework'. When you arrive at that page, install the framework.

If your version of Windows is XP, you might have to download and install the Microsoft Speech Recognition program.
